Radiation is useful in an x-ray examination

X-ray examination uses just enough radiation to take a sufficiently precise image.

- Radiation does not leak outside the imaged area.
- When using modern X-ray equipment, radiation shields for patients are usually not necessary.
- Patient shielding may also interfere with the automated functions of the equipment or obstruct the imaged areas.
